

**Sun City Grand Singles Club
General Membership Meeting
January 13, 2008**

The meeting was called to order by Brenda Parker in the absence of Les Kane at 5:50 p.m.. Joe Rayo, working on his own, presented a charity to members and asked for their help. It was the Child Help project. He raised \$3000 and donated to this charity.


Donn reported that they old Board had turned over a balance of approximately \$2000 to the new Board. He then turned the meeting over to Brenda.
