

**SCG SINGLES CLUB BOARD MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 pm.

The March minutes were approved via email.

**President's Report: Jerry Bing**

- Jerry said that Lorrie Schaut had sent her an email about the sensitivity she and others have to the scent of perfumes and lotions. After discussion, the Board decided that a sentence in the calendar and eBlasts would be a good idea to remind all members to not wear perfumes or lotions to public events, because it can be very allergic to some people. Novelle offered to write an announcement and send it out to the Board for approval before we put the notice in the eBlasts and/or calendar.
- Jerry reminded us all to communicate to each other by email. For example if you cannot attend a Board meeting, send Jerry an email saying so and get someone to cover you.
- Jerry reminds us of the rule regarding return of tickets. If sales are still going on, tickets can be returned for a refund. But if the deadline for sales has passed, they cannot be returned. A reminder of this info should be put into eBlasts.
- Jerry read a letter from Sherman Kalina in which he expressed appreciation to the Board of the SCSingles Club and all the volunteers who work to create fun activities. He has gone back North now, but said he looks forward to returning to fun activities and friends.

### **Treasurer, Roger Tharp**

Roger reported that our bank balance is \$9165. He distributed a report of activity that shows results year to date.

### **Vice President, James Popiel**

### **Activities, Novelle Ballard**

- June activities need more work. Novelle said we need at least one event for the first Sunday. If we do not have an event for the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday, that might be acceptable for the summer.

- Darlene was absent, but the Board discussed the new location for social hour and ticket sales, the West End Diner. Ticket sales are good there, and the attendance is good.
- John Tuel's party is almost sold out; 54 tickets have been sold.

**Membership, Charlotte Wilkinson**

Charlotte was absent. We need to know if she is planning on having new member meetings at Cimarron in May or June.

**Old Business**

Next month the Board will discuss the situation at Coco's and the site usage fee baskets.

**New Business**
